International Workshop Agreements

An International Workshop Agreement is a document developed outside the normal ISO committee system to enable market players to negotiate in an "open workshop " environment. International Workshop Agreements are typically administratively supported by a member body. The published agreement includes an indication of the participating organizations involved in its development. An International Workshop Agreement has a maximum lifespan of six years, after which it can be either transformed into another ISO deliverable or is automatically withdrawn.




Advantages of IWA

✓ More flexible to transfer into a new TC(Technical Committee)




Other ISO deliverables will spent more than 3 years to develop. And two rounds ballots are needed before NP approval.



Humane Entrepreneurship: How Focusing on People Can Drive a New Era of Wealth and Quality Job Creation in a Sustainable World

During the next 15 years, 40 million jobs need to be created each year in order to keep pace with population growth and foster greater participation of small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) in a globally integrated economy. Our paper proposes a new theory that integrates the sustainable use of natural resources, better use of produced capital, and further investment in buman capital. Our new theory, Humane Entrepreneurship (HumEnt), encompasses three key research domains: Entrepreneurship, Leadership, and Human Resource Management. The HumEnt theory presents a new perspective on how to create 40 million quality jobs each year and helps address global challenges.

Introduction

Where—exactly—is the wealth of nations? A decade ago, when the World Bank published a book asking that important question, they introduced the concept of wealth as a complementary indicator to gross domestic product (GDP) for monitoring sustainable development in a country. For the first time, the World Bank demonstrated that development is about managing a broad portfolio of assets—produced, human, and natural capital.

Nobel Laureate Joseph Stiglitz observed that a business is always evaluated by both its income statement and its balance sheet (assets and liabilities, or wealth). However, as it pertains to the economic performance of countries, measurement is based only on national income, with national wealth being largely ignored. The World Bank report proposed a new and holistic view of a country's comprehensive national wealth, which can determine whether GDP growth is sustainable in the long run (Lange, Wodon, and Carey 2018).

The United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), created at the beginning of 2016, were built upon the United Nations' previous Millennium Development Goals and set a new global agenda to eradicate extreme poverty and shift the world onto a sustainable path by 2030. The SDGs are comprehensive and include goals on extreme poverty reduction, education and health, the environment, and peaceful and inclusive societies. The 17 SDGs and their 169 targets are interrelated, as progress toward one goal can enable advancement in others. At present, there is no agreed-upon macroeconomic indicator of sustainability; however, the measurement and monitoring of a country's change in wealth per capita over time-including natural and human capital-can help fill this void.

Wealth is considered the assets base which enables countries to generate income (GDP)

Guidlines for humane entrepreneurship - principles and framework

Purpose and justification

To transition the proposal for *Guidance for humane entrepreneurship* into the IWA of International Standard. Although ISO already has standards on the human-centred, such as ISO 27500 and ISO 27501, the new proposal is still different from them. The new item is based on integrated model of entrepreneurship for sustainable growth in an organization, aiming at profits (business development) and people (human resource / talent development) simultaneously. It emphasizes humane entrepreneurship (thereafter, HumEnt) including business-side (entrepreneurial orientation: EO) and human-side (humane orientation: HO) entrepreneurship rather than business entrepreneurship. The new item highlights intersection between employers and employees through envisioning (sharing values) and empathy (sharing emotions).

Justification 1: Establishing standards in the field of humane entrepreneurship will help common understanding of both human resource management and enterprise Innovation, and provide better practices on human-based entrepreneurial management and global solutions to




